DEAR MEMBERS & FRIENDS:

Thank you for your great support in 2021! We have fortunately fundraised most of the required funds for upgrading our computer hardware and system to support 2022 computer capabilities.

Our new Education Director, Susanne Dumas, has made great strides already with increased booking for Education programming and tours of our facilities. May and June programs are nearly filled to capacity! We hope to find a few new volunteers to help, especially with our museum tours this Spring.

Going forward, we are working on a new exhibit for the Dutch House which will center on voting in Fort Edward at the turn of the 20th Century. The exhibit will be complete with voting booths from District #5, Fort Miller booths 18, 19, and 20, which were given to us by the Fort Miller Reformed Church, who own the Old Town Voting Space.

We will start off the year with our fundraising booth space at the Washington County Antique Fair from April 29th until May 1st. Our museum will reopen for tours on Wednesday, June 1st, and in the following weeks we will have our first events of the year. The Riverside School Bell Awards will be held on June 9th and we have received several Nominations for the 2022 awards. The committee has decided on three recipients at this time. A separate invitation will be mailed to you in May for the celebration. Also, an "Old Fashioned Strawberry Social" is being planned for June 18th from 12:30 pm until 4 pm. Those with up to date memberships will receive a free strawberry shortcake. Bring a friend or family member for \$5.00 shortcakes. Memberships can be bought or renewed during the event to receive a free shortcake as well! Because of continuing pandemic concerns, we will not be having our fundraising auction again this year. Until a time when our volunteer ranks are increased and pandemic safety concerns are no longer an issue, we do not feel comfortable running the event.

A note about our collection should be of interest to our members. We work with a handful of volunteers all year long on collection concerns from storage to scanning items. COVID gave a lot of people time to review things that they have had for years, resulting in items being surrendered into our care. They are small collections, but they tell the larger story of our local community. One very large project has been made possible by our computer upgrade. You have heard us talk about the Stone Collection (Bloomer) over the years and we are currently in possession of a number of negatives from the original studio. The negatives include portraits, weddings, business, school groups, and more. These items have been archivally stored for over thirty years, but were never printed because of the expense. Currently, we have begun the scanning of the A's, which amount to about 500 negatives, with thousands of negatives to go. This project will take a few years. Check in with us periodically to monitor our progress!


